TOWNSEND & BRANTFORD - We are pleased to announce that an Amalgamation Proposal and Agreement between Brant Family and Children's Services (Brant FACS) and The Children's Aid Society of Haldimand and Norfolk (CASHN) were approved by the community Boards of Directors and Memberships of both organizations late last week.

The Amalgamation Proposal is now with the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services (MCCSS) as required by the Child, Youth and Family Services Act, 2017. Upon receiving approval from MCCSS, the application will be submitted to the Ontario Public Guardian and Trustee (MAG) and Service Ontario for final government approvals. Should all approvals be received, the Amalgamation will take effect April 1, 2022.

The Boards of Directors of both agencies would like to thank our Staff, Resource Families, Community Partners and other Stakeholders for input received during initial consultations. The consultative process will continue through the next steps of implementation planning.

We would also like to thank the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services for all of their support throughout this process.

It has been a privilege for our two agencies to serve our respective communities for over 100 years. We are grateful for the opportunity to continue to meet the needs of the children and families we work with, as we move forward under a collective vision.
